ADDITIONAL INFO ON BACK

- DEADLINE** — The deadline to register for the spring season with guaranteed placement (on the same team as last fall) is Friday, March 16, 2012. Players must have been four years old or older on July 31, 2011. A birth certificate copy is required with registration if not provided previously.
- SCHEDULE** — Each team will play eight games (usually on Saturdays) during the spring season, which is expected to run

from April 14 to May 19. Rosters will be announced at coach's meetings on March 31. Practices will begin shortly thereafter, with each coach determining his or her own practice schedule.

- WHAT YOU NEED** — Shin guards, socks that cover them, a water bottle, and a soccer ball (size 3 for U6/U8, 4 for U10/U12, and 5 for U14 & up). Soccer cleats are recommended.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Teams are coached by parents or volunteers. We will provide training, so please consider coaching your child's team!
- Registrations are allowed after the March 16 deadline, but they will incur a \$10 per player late fee. See "Late Registration and Refund Policies" below for details.
- Players must be four years old or older as of July 31, 2011. The division in which children play is determined by age on that date.
- A birth certificate copy is required with registration for players new to SoccerMadison (see below).
- Players are kept on the same teams in the spring season that

they were on as in the fall, provided they meet the registration deadline. (Please let us know if you'd like a change of team.)

- We expect to continue co-ed play for Under-6 (U6) and U8 players. If we do have enough players for same-sex leagues, we will contact parents to which approach is preferred.
- We expect to continue co-ed play for U10s, and twice-a-week practices for the U12-and-up group. We are investigating playing same-sex friendlies in the Dakota League for the U10s, and will consult parents to see what the interest level is in playing out-of-town games as things develop.

BIRTH CERTIFICATES

As of fall 2009 the US Soccer Federation has mandated that every player's date of birth be verified with a copy of their Birth Certificate, which must accompany the registration form for all players new to SoccerMadison. It will be kept on file.

Proof of age shall consist of a State-Certified Birth Certificate, a Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card (DD form 1173) issued by the uniformed services of the United States, birth registration issued by an appropriate government agency,

drivers license, Board of Health records, passports, alien registration card issued by the U.S. Government, or certificate issued by the Immigration and Naturalization Service attesting to age or certification of an American citizen born abroad issued by an appropriate government agency. SoccerMadison cannot accept hospital certificates or baptismal records.

A player is not officially registered until their date of birth has been verified with a Birth Certificate or other approved document.

LATE REGISTRATION AND REFUND POLICIES

Registrations are accepted up to the specified deadlines for the Fall and Spring seasons. Registrations received or postmarked after the specified deadlines incur a \$10 late fee per player.

After that date, registrations will still be accepted and players will be added to teams that still have room. If there are no teams that have space for additional players, new registrations will be placed

on a waiting list for approximately two weeks, at which time if no players have dropped from a team or there are not enough players to create an additional team, the check will be returned.

Refunds are generally not allowed once teams are formed, but will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

This care may be given under whatever conditions are necessary to preserve the life or well being of my dependant.
